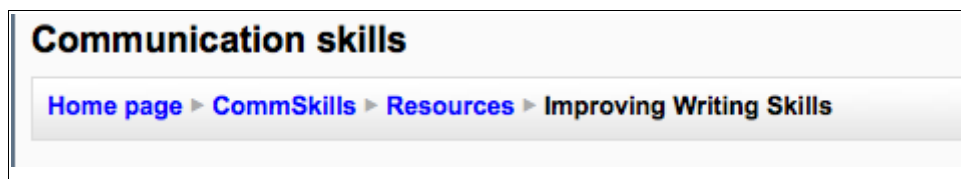
Navigation

This Moodleguide will help you navigate around your Moodle site.

Moodle offers several navigation aids available to you so that you do not get lost.

The examples here are from a Moodle course called *CommSkills*.

'Breadcrumbs' at top left of screen



In this example, you are in the *Improving Writing Skills* part of the course. *Resources* is another link that is a summary of all the resources on the course page.

The *CommSkills* link will take you to the course front page which links to all the parts of the course.

Homepage will take you to a page which lists all the courses you are registered on.

This is how the resources page looks.

Moodle is designed so that the browser back button always works by taking you back one step. Try it.

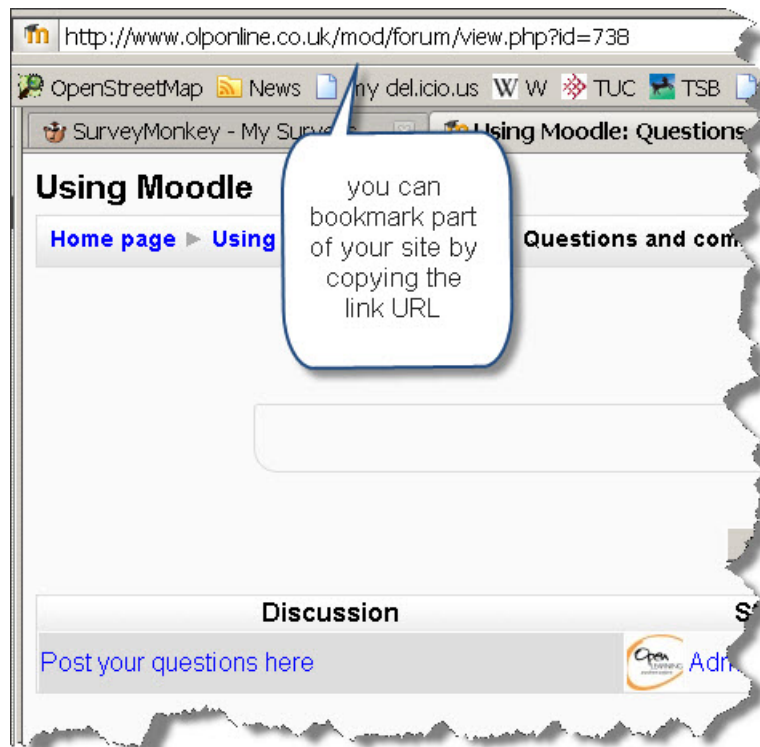
The jump to links
