what you can do with Moodle

This Moodleguide will help you to:

- think about what Moodle can do for you
- plan your Moodle project

what will Moodle do?

Moodle is an open source project built on standard web tools. One consequence of this is that most things you can do on the web can be done in Moodle.

Some examples:

offer a library of documents to download
show videos or sound files
collect links to other sites
host an online discussion board
send instant messages
put up online registration or order forms
display a photo collection
show news headlines
monitor site usage
host online portfolios
administer tests and exams

what can you do?

By using all the tools contained in Moodle and uploading your own materials into them you can build a huge range of different types of Moodle sites. Here are just a few we have helped with.

develop elearning modules
learning network Moodle for union representatives
document library for NVQ candidates
induction programme for new health service staff
online course system
course administration site handling registrations and bookings
modules for statutory training with computer marked tests
local history site with interviews, blogs and recordings
project management, with documents and meetings calendar
taster site to encourage course take up
online portfolio site for learners taking qualifications
blended learning site to add to face to face sessions
staff development programme
